BEECHER FRASIER

BEECHER FRASIER, a veteran of federal and state public policy, joined The Ingram Group and its Washington operation in early 2014 as a principal. From 2003 to 2010, Beecher served as chief of staff to U.S. Congressman Lincoln Davis of Tennessee's fourth congressional district. As the Davis' chief policy and political advisor, Beecher was responsible for the congressman's work on the Appropriations Committee and the Financial Services Committee. Additionally, he served as the congressman's key liaison with other congressional chiefs of staff, the White House, the Administration, and other government agencies.

While working for Congressman Davis, Beecher was active in the Blue Dog Coalition, an alliance of common sense, pro-business House democrats. A skilled campaigner, he took a six month leave of absence from his post in Davis' office to run former Congressman Harold Ford Jr.'s competitive 2006 race for U.S. Senate.

His areas of expertise include education policy, energy policy, the nuclear weapons complex, appropriations, and nonprofits.
